1. Print the CBE Program Acceptance email you will receive from the Program Staff after you have been matched with a project and attach it to a Course Add/Drop Form (available in your CBE orientation package or from your academic department office).
2. Have your course instructor (Faculty Supervisor) sign the Course Add/Drop Form.
3. Give the signed Course Add/Drop Form (with this permission email attached) to Office of the Registrar in Blackburn Hall.

Staff in the Office of the Registrar will register you in the course.

Normal add/drop deadlines are in effect for TCCBE and U-Links courses.
